## PACKING SUGGESTIONS

### CLOTHING

- 1 rain jacket
- 1 warm jacket
- 2 pairs of jeans
- Shorts/skirts
- 3 casual shirts
- 4 T-shirts
- Jacket and trousers or dresses (for evenings out – elegant/retro/funky)
- 1 warm sweater
- Tracksuit
- Socks (lots)
- Undies (lots)
- Nightwear
- Cozzies (swim wear) and towel
- Hat

### SHOES

- Comfortable shoes (for outdoor activities)
- Sandals/thongs/flip flops
- Going out shoes

### TOILETRIES

- Toiletry bag and contents
- Sunblock lotion
- Insect repellent
- Medications
- Hankies/tissue

### MISCELLANEOUS

- Sunglasses
- Sewing kit
- Small first aid kit
- Writing/sketching materials
- Small torch (flashlight)
- Day bag/pack
- Small devices (e.g. camera, phone, laptop, tablet, harmonica)
- Moolar/Currency/Aussie dollars
- Power adaptor\*

\*The official voltage for Australia (and New Zealand) is 240 volts with most electrical goods operating at around the 220 – 240 volt mark. Both Australia and New Zealand operate on the same 3-pronged outlet.
