Thank you so much for your patience. Hamish, Angus and I have been working hard to make the BROTHER Down Under trip all it can be. Launch date is imminent.

It has taken longer that we anticipated with, among other things, some last minute obstacles to clear in regard to how we will be accepting payments. We want to iron out any possible glitches before we launch. And we want to let you know, ahead of everyone else, as many details as possible. So here we go...

What will we be up to in Oz?

We'll be traveling the whole time with the band as our tour guides. (Depending on tour numbers, we'll either be traveling by coach or touring van. Either way we'll be very comfortable and side-by-side with the fellas). This will be an intimate journey!

The ticket price includes round trip airfare from LA to Sydney; 12 days of travel; 11 nights accommodation; entrance fees and taxes; 11 dinners and 11 breakfasts.

There are 6 scheduled concerts, each in a very different setting, including a woodshed performance, a theater show in Hamish's hometown, a campfire sing-along and a house concert at Hamish's place!

Tour highlights include a night time cruise of Sydney Harbor - with a gourmet dinner and the first BROTHER show with Hamish back on stage; Sydney Opera House tour; The Blue Mountains - including a scenic cable car ride and a wander along a Jurassic forest trail; Historic Hill End Village: a classic Aussie winery/goat creamery, close to the bush haven where the brothers recorded their meditation album; gold panning; Aboriginal culture immersion day; a beach picnic with wild kangaroos; The National Gallery (with the most extensive collection of indigenous art in the world); Parliament House; The War Museum (Hamish and Angus



say the museum is mind blowing and quite moving); a visit to Bathurst, the brothers' home town (If we're lucky we may even drop by the old family farm); lots of beach time, including surf or paddle board lessons with world champions if you're feeling it!)

It looks like the ticket price will probably be \$5899, per person, for a double room. Single supplement will be \$340. You will be able to make several smaller payments over the coming months if you choose. We know it won't be cheap, but it is Australia! We're doing our best to keep the price down while packing as many good things in as possible. We know you will be thrilled with the journey we'll take you on!
